Lac La Biche County continues to strongly work in partnership with Alberta Public Safety and Emergency Services to deliver a wide range of training to Community Peace Officers and other law enforcement professionals in Alberta. We are excited to announce our 2024 CPOIP classes!

August 19, 2024 - November 7, 2024

This intensive 12-week program covers a wide variety of training including: legal studies, physical fitness, strategic communication, use of force training, shotgun training, RADAR/LiDAR training, and the Emergency Vehicle Operators Course (EVOC). This program is accredited by Alberta Public Safety and Emergency Services.

This program is open to both self-funded students, and students who are employed by a municipality. Training is conducted 10-hours per day, 4-days per week. The cost of the program includes accommodations, thanks to our partner Portage College.
