The Alberta Association of Community Peace Officers (AACPO) is comprised of over 125 agencies (members) that are represented by more than 1,700 Officers from across Alberta. These Officers are employed by local Counties, Municipalities and Organizations to provide provincial statute and municipal bylaw enforcement to the communities in which they serve. Peace Officers don't just enforce rules and laws. Many are emergency 1st responders that regularly attended motor vehicle collisions, emergency situations and disasters. Peace Officers can be found patrolling roadways, neighbourhoods, parks, transit systems, hospitals, and more to ensure public safety within the communities they serve. Many of our officers can be found filling other roles in their community as well such as Animal Control, Emergency Management and Disaster Services members, Child Seat Technicians and School Resource Officers. Off duty these Officers are active in their communities volunteering as sports coaches, members of local Search and Rescue Teams or taking part in programs like D.A.R.E. and the Special Olympics.

Each year the AACPO hosts an annual training conference complete with a Trade Show and an evening Awards Banquet. The Awards Banquet offers us the opportunity to celebrate officers who receive special awards and medals from the Association, Provincial and federal Governments for the work they do. The training conference and Trade Show is open to all Law Enforcement members and attracts Officers from across Alberta and beyond. Officers from the Northwest Territories, the Yukon, Saskatchewan, BC, Fish and Wildlife, Commercial Vehicle Enforcement and Police Agencies have all attended our Conferences over the years.
