Protect infrastructure and public safety within Special Areas parks, including foot and boat patrols. Investigate public inquiries, complaints, and concerns as needed. Represent the Special Areas Board professionally in court proceedings, ensuring proper evidence handling and compliance with legal standards. Educate the public on municipal policies and provincial statutes, promoting voluntary compliance. |
| Requirements: | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Education and Experience: We welcome applicants with a variety of backgrounds and are open to considering a combination of relevant experience, skills, and education. If you have the right mindset, strong potential, and a passion for public safety, training opportunities are available to help you succeed in this role. Certification: Possess or be eligible for a Level 1 Community Peace Officer appointment from Alberta Justice & Solicitor General. Enforcement Experience: While three (3) years of experience as a Peace Officer is preferred, we recognize that skills gained in other enforcement, security, or public safety roles may also be valuable. Experience with municipal bylaw enforcement and park patrols is an asset but not mandatory. Specialized Knowledge: Familiarity with Provincial Statutes, MRF, report management software, ROADS, and other enforcement-related systems is beneficial. Candidates eager to learn and develop this expertise will be considered. Tactical Training: Approved certifications in Defensive Baton, Oleoresin Capsicum (OC) Spray, and shotgun use are preferred.
